Top 10 Things to Know About a Neighborhood Center at the Old Gas Station at the corner of Bethel and San Francisco

- In the summer of 2106, ONNA (the Olympia Northeast Neighborhoods Alliance www.olynna.com) was the first community in the City of Olympia to develop a subarea (neighborhood) plan.
- 2. Subarea planning is conducted through a collaborative effort by community members and the City, and is used to shape how neighborhoods grow and develop.
- 3. One of top 3 goals that ONNA adopted was to establish a vision for a Neighborhood Center at the corner of Bethel and San Francisco Ave) by December 2017.
- 4. A survey was sent to all NE Olympia residents in early 2016 to gauge interest in the what residents might like to see at the corner.
- 5. 85% of survey respondents indicated they would like ONNA to explore the concept of a neighborhood center further. The survey results indicated the following top 3 uses for this site: small grocery, mixed use 3-story building or a restaurant.
- 6. The old gas station is for sale, and has known soil contamination but the extent of the contamination isn't fully understood.
- 7. There has been interest from private investors into developing the corner but no firm plans.

- 8. ONNA representatives have been speaking with nearby property owners, neighbors and private investors to learn more about the possibilities of developing that corner into more a neighborhood asset and share the goals of the ONNA subarea plan.
- 9. Community discussion and input for this site is important so that private developers can better understand what the community would find useful to our neighborhood.
- 10. A community vision is desired for a neighborhood center at this location before the end of 2017.
