Picnic Table Platform:


A picnic table has existed in the Bigelow Springs Park for a few years. It moves around, and is never on level ground. This proposal is to make a level platform for it to rest on.

- An 8' x 10' site would be dug down and leveled, such that the eventual platform would be at least 1" above the surrounding grass along any edge.
- The platform would be framed by pressure treated 2" x 6"'s, moored to the ground every 2.5 linear feet with 1-foot-long, 1/2" rebar.
- Weed cloth would be secured beneath the future gravel
- 1.5 cubic yards of decomposed, compacted granite gravel (or concrete, if preferred) would be placed.

The location would be arranged with OPARD, but two likely spots are shown at right:
